Over the past several years, the number of clients that we serve has doubled. The work we do has increased in complexity, but our vision has stayed the same. To help accomplish our vision that "No one should know the hurt of hunger", the Board of Directors voted to create two positions from one. We will now have a President of the Board (volunteer) and also an Executive Director (nominal part-time salary). To split the position, several tasks had to happen.

- A team was formed to write a job description for each role. Both descriptions were presented to the Board and approved by the same. In general, the Board President will provide Board oversight, and the Executive Director will be responsible for all day-to-day operations.
- Nominations were taken for the next President of the Board. Bob Thurman was nominated then later approved by the Board at IFM's annual meeting. We welcome Bob to this role and look forward to the leadership he will provide to our organization! As Bob steps into this role and Sue steps down, we also look to Sue with deep gratitude for all of her devoted work and stewardship that she poured into the Board Presidency over the past four years.
